Instructions

Papers should include an abstract and full paper.

All submitted articles should be written in English. They should clearly include: title, brief abstract, list of keywords; author(s)' full name(s), affiliation(s), complete address(es), and e-mail.

Abstract should be between 100-150 words.

The full article should be written in Microsoft Word. All full papers submitted to the conference will be reviewed by a special Editorial Review Committee.

High quality papers addressing substantial research questions will be invited to be revised in response to reviewer comments and suggestions. Papers passing the review will be included in the Congress Proceedings.

The full article submission should be left justified in entirety, 12-point, Times font, single-spaced with no bold, italic, or underlined text. Submit the full paper to fgonzalez@upvt.edu.mx with an email subject line of GSDI-10 between 5-20 pages on letter with margins around one inch. Deadline for submission of full Papers: October 13rd, 2007
